THE PRESBYTERY OF BOSTON EAST BOSTON FUND

Mission, Leadership, Education Grant Guidelines

CRITERIA

- 1. Project proposals should be submitted by one or more congregations of the Boston Presbytery. Involvement by more than one congregation will be given priority.
- 2. Projects that represent a new Mission Outreach for our Presbytery will be favored.
- 3. Proposals from congregations with at least a three-year history of providing 5-10% of their budget for Presbytery approved mission will receive first priority.

PROCEDURE

- 1.At least annually, CEM and CS&D will distribute an announcement of the availability of theses funds along with these guidelines.
- 2. A 'Mission/Leadership/Education Project Funding Request' may be completed for a fully planned project, including budget. Mission requests are forwarded to the Committee on Education for Mission (CEM) Chair; Leadership/Education requests are forwarded to the Committee on Church Support and Development (CS&D) Chair.
 - 3. Congregations submitting requests must include a recent financial statement.
- 4. Normally grants will be for no more than three years, and will decrease over the life of the grant. Annual reviews are necessary to continue funding.
- 5. The committees will consider requests in a timely fashion, at least quarterly. Upon approval, the request will move to the next review/approval step.
- 6. Grants normally will be no more than 50% of the total project cost. We will not fund the whole project. Grants larger than \$5,000 need Council or Presbytery endorsement.
 - 7. No group, church, or individual will receive more than one grant per year.
- 8. Reports to the appropriate committee should indicate progress of the project, goal achievement, and financial integrity of the partnership. A final written report, which becomes the property of the committee, is required at the conclusion of the funding cycle or when the project is completed

EXCLUSIONS: i.e. established local chapters of national organizations; established food pantries, clothes closets, etc.; operational costs for established preschools or daycare programs, etc.
